SECOND ANNUAL POLAR PLUNGE IS ON THE WAY

Sheriff Carter Weaver is announcing the launch of fund-raising for the second annual Georgetown County Polar Plunge to benefit Special Olympics.

The event will be Saturday, Feb. 5, 2022, at Litchfield Inn. Registration begins at 10 a.m. with a costume contest at 11 a.m. and the plunge into the cold Atlantic at 11:30 a.m. High temperatures only reached the 40's for the first Polar Plunge, and participants splashed happily into the water. Georgetown County Sheriff's Office, its sponsors and partners, raised nearly \$22,000 for the inaugural event last February and hope to do even better the second time around.
